U.S. Navy Commemorates Annapolis.

Recognizing its historic bond with the Naval Academy and the sea, the Navy names a new submarine after this Sailing Capital. This honor comes with decorum and obligation. To assure that, in November 1989, the city formed a Commemorative Committee. Charged to organize events and activities celebrating commissioning of SSN 760, its mission is to offer you a part of history.



Boat's Captain, Lt. Cmdr. Richard Severinghaus, thanked Honorary Chairwoman, the Honorable Marjorie Holt for her enthusiasm in supporting this project from its mid-1980s beginnings.

Funds raised through this catalog will be used to sponsor commissioning events both at Groton, Connecticut and in Annapolis, Maryland. Then over SSN 760's service life, the committee will support the boat's crew on visits to ports around the world.

SSN 760 launched last May in Groton begins its tour of service in Spring of 1992. It is one of the most technically advanced nuclear powered submarines in the world.

Its crew, in time honored tradition, has established a close, personal Annapolitan relationship with committee members, business owners and community leaders. Many in the crew are now Honorary Citizens of Annapolis, thanks to Mayor Hopkins.

Before sliding into the water, members of the crew on a visit to city schools thanked many area students for entering last year's art contest.

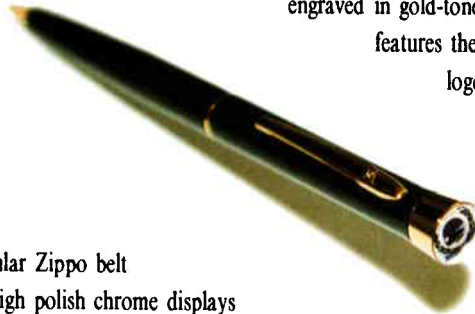
